ORDER

In super session of all previous orders, the Government of India hereby re-constitutes General Body of the Sports Authority of India (SAI) with immediate effect. The composition of the new General Body of the SAI is given below:-

3. Where the member of the General Body is by virtue of his/her office or appointment which he/she holds, her/his membership of the General Body shall terminate when he/she ceases to hold that office or appointment.
 4. The above members of the General Body except ex-officio shall hold office for a period of three years from the date of his/her nomination or from the date of issue of this order, whichever is later.
 5. The membership of the General Body shall be terminated on the happenings of any of the following events:-

- I. the expiry of the period of membership as prescribed in para (3) and para (4) above.
 - II. death, resignation, insolvency, lunacy or conviction for a criminal offence or moral turpitude.
 - III. When a member himself/herself declines to serve on the General Body or his/her employer refuses to grant him/her permission to serve on the body and
 - IV. when a member does not attend three consecutive meetings of the General Body without prior leave of the President.
6. The decision of the President with regard to termination of the membership or removal of any member shall be final.
 7. A member will be entitled to facilities and privileges as per the provisions of Memorandum of Association and rules of the society.
 8. The meeting of the General Body shall be held on such date, time and place as may be determined by the President.
